### Exiles and Psychoanalysis

*It is a fact that the question of exile concerns psychoanalysis in a special way. In the first place, this is because psychoanalysis is marked by the experience of exile.*

*It may be enough to refer to Freud's forced exile and his certainty that the return to Vienna was impossible. His was not the first exile in the history of psychoanalysis, as many others followed. A question imposes itself: is it necessary to refer to the displacement of the body from a territory to another to evoke exile?*

*The expression 'internal exile', which appeared in Spain during the Franco era shows by itself that we must re-define what we understand by 'exile'.*

*The reference to the work of Lacan is at this point unavoidable. This is essentially so because Lacan defined a structural, generalised exile that concerns every human being. What is this exile? What are the consequences of this conception for the direction of the treatment?*

*In this seminar, therefore, we shall approach our social context, marked by questions about immigration, segregation and exile, as well as the way in which psychoanalysis receives these questions and their manifestations in the clinic. The analytic clinic, indeed, often demonstrates that analysands and analysts embark in the voyage of exile.*

*Once exile is defined from a psychoanalytic perspective, we shall attempt to show the vicissitudes of the affects of exile and the different usages of a language other than the so called maternal tongue in those who go up to the end of what can be expected from an analysis.*
