The difference and the relation between the sexes

Is the difference between the sexes natural or is it cultural? The matter has been at issue in Western society and in the psychoanalytic field for several decades, at least since the American psychiatrist Robert Stoller introduced the distinction between sex and gender and the notion of a gender identity. Jacques Lacan proposed an altogether different approach: a logical one. For he considered there is a logic of sex derived from the Freudian experience which was in need of elaboration. The question about the difference between the sexes then appears to be necessarily linked to that of their relationship.

Sol Aparicio, PhD, is a psychoanalyst in private practice in Paris and at the Outpatient Service of the Villejuif Psychiatric Hospital. She is a founding member and an Analyst Member of the School of Psychoanalysis of the Forums of the Lacanian Field and teaches psychoanalysis at the Collège Clinique de Paris and in other countries. She regularly publishes articles on psychoanalytic theory and practice.
